Sean Cloyes

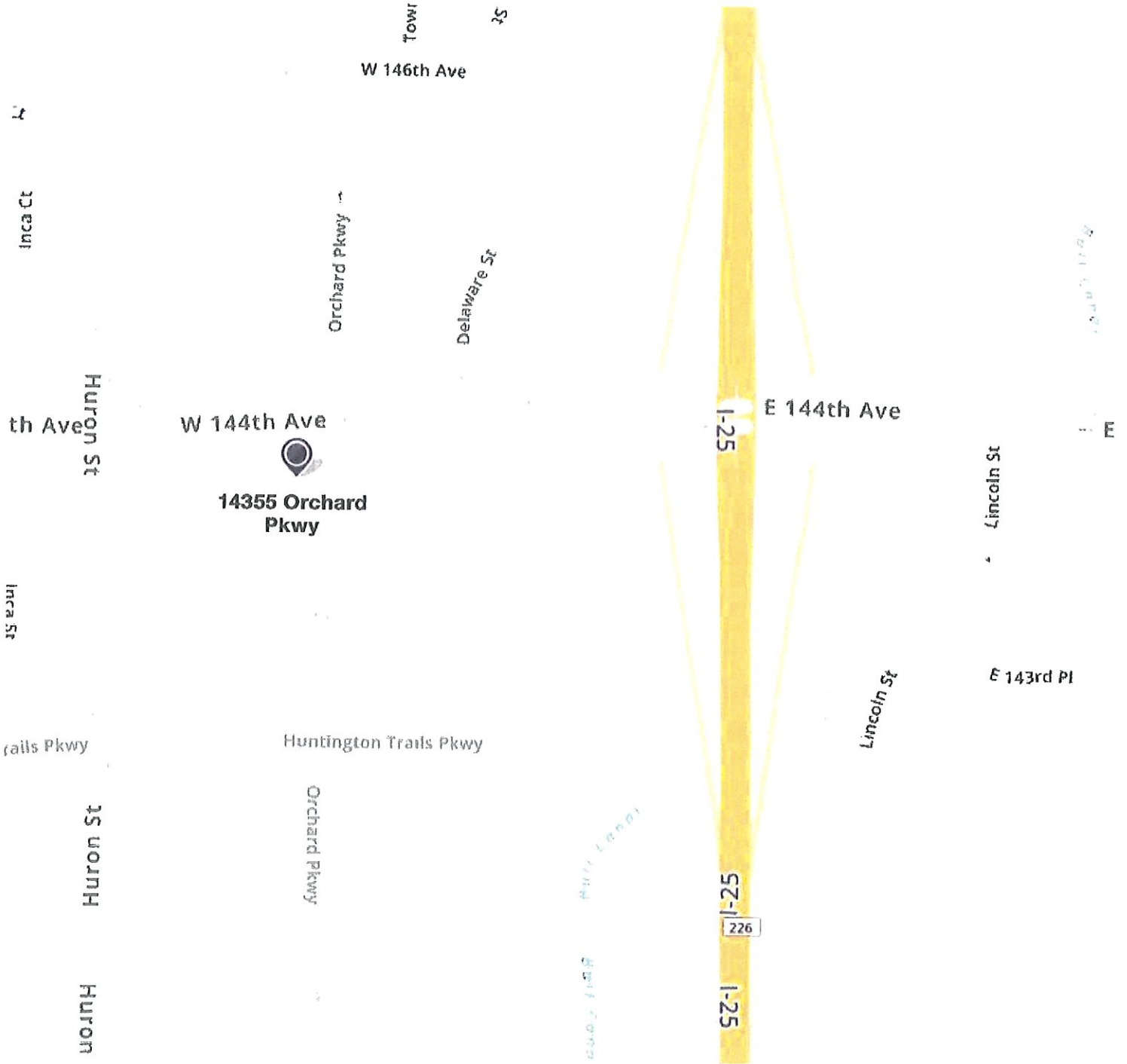
